



Going with the Gospel

INTRODUCTION: Most people are living busy lives, running here and there with all sorts of obligations and commitments. As a result, many are distracted from the mission that Jesus calls us to. In this message, we learn how the mission isn't an additional thing we must add to our lives. Instead, it should be at the very heart of who we are and what we do so that as we are going, we go intentionally as missionaries for Jesus.

READ: Acts 1:1-14

DISCUSSION:

1. How many errands do you run on a typical day? What places do you regularly go to? How many people do you interact with?
2. How would your life be different if you viewed your various errands and experiences as missionary opportunities?
 - In what ways would this inconvenience you?
 - In what ways would this benefit the Kingdom of God and you?
3. What can you do to intentionally have Gospel conversations in your everyday life?
 - What are some specific ways that you can implement this in the places you go? Be specific. For example, if you go to the grocery store on a regular basis, what can you do to interact with others and initiate a gospel conversation?
 - What things often prevent you from doing this?
4. Why does it seem easier for us to caught up on minor issues and neglect the main issue of sharing the Gospel?
 - How do we overcome this?
 - How did Jesus respond to this when dealing with the disciples?
5. This message revealed three primary roles of the Holy Spirit. List them out.
 - Which one of these do you feel you need most right now?
 - How do these roles effect our witness for Christ?
6. What is the definition of a "witness"? What does witness do in court? How does this relate to our "witness" for Christ?
7. Take some time and give testimony to the group of what the Lord has done in your life.
 - What are some things that the Lord has done in your life to reveal Himself to you?
 - What have you seen and heard about Jesus?
 - Who can you share this with outside of this body of believers?
8. What four general locations did Jesus identify as the mission field for the early disciples?
 - What did this reveal about His desire for all people everywhere?
 - How does this relate to us?
 - Where is our Jerusalem, Judea, Samara, and uttermost parts of the earth?
9. What evangelism "plans" do you need to make to help you be intentional in sharing the Good News with others?
